A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”) regarding the Application of Solar Pepper Power, LLC (“SPP” or “Applicant”) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility to authorize the Serrano Gen-Tie Project (the “Project”). The Project consists of a new collection substation located in Pima County and/or Pinal County and a double-circuit Gen-Tie that will deliver electricity generated at the Serrano Solar and Storage Project to the regional grid at the existing Arizona Public Service (“APS”) Saguaro Facility and/or the existing Tucson Electric Power (“TEP”) Tortolita Substation. 25 area in which the Project is to be located desiring to become a party to the proceedings
